Through Kijik's Non-profit organization, Qizhjeh Heritage Institute (QHI), Kijik shareholders and descendants are eligible to apply for scholarships to fund educational, post-secondary and vocational training opportunities. The Kijik Corporation Board of Directors' Education Committee comprises the Governing Board of QHI and administers the Scholarship Program.

The deadline is June 28, 2024 at 5:00 pm AKDT.

Your completed scholarship application packet must be received (not postmarked) by Kijik Corporation at 801 B Street, Suite 401B Anchorage AK 99501 by 5:00 pm AKDT on June 28th, 2024. Applicants may submit their scholarship applications electronically via email. The email address to submit applications is: info@kijikcorp.com. Please use the applicants name and the words "2024 QHI Scholarship Application" in the subject line. It is highly recommended that the applicant calls the Kijik office (please leave a message) to confirm the electronic submission was received. Application submitted via certified mail will continue to be accepted. Faxed applications are not accepted.

A. WHO MAY APPLY

- 1. Shareholders of Kijik and descendants of shareholders.
- 2. Students currently accepted to or enrolled in nationally or regionally accredited institutions of higher education or vocational schools. Students enrolled in non-accredited institutions or higher education may apply and may be considered under the "Special Fields" category.
- **3.** Applications for full-time credit will receive preference, but less than full-time enrollment will be considered.
- **4.** Recipients of QHI scholarship in previous years may reapply.



5. Applicants who already hold a degree or have vocational training may apply, but the Qizhjeh Heritage Institute will give first priority to individuals who are seeking their first degree or who have no previous vocational training.

B. APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **1.** Each Kijik scholarship applicant must submit a completed application to be considered for a scholarship. A completed application includes the following items:
 - **a.** Scholarship Program Application
 - **b.** Essay
 - c. Current Resume
 - **d.** Most recent official high school or college transcript
 - e. Two Letters of recommendation (if new applicant)
 - **f.** A copy of an acceptance letter from school in which you plan to attend (if new applicant)
- 2. It is highly recommended that you send your application to the Kijik Corporation Office "certified/return receipt" via US Postal Service and keep a copy for your records. This will be your documentation that the application was received by the deadline. Please do not submit your application in a spine binder, as several copies have to be made.
- **3.** Applicants may submit their scholarship applications electronically via email. The email address to submit applications is: info@kijikcorp.com. Please use the applicants name and the words "2024 QHI Scholarship Application" in the subject line. It is highly recommended that the applicant call the Kijik office (please leave a message) to confirm the electronic submission was received. Application submitted via certified mail will continue to be accepted.
- **4.** Applications that are sent via fax machines are not acceptable.

C. <u>REVIEW PROCESS</u>

The Qizhjeh Heritage Institute awards scholarships primarily on the basis of scholastic achievements; it also considers the applicant's character, leadership abilities, and educational goals.

Within each scholarship category, ranking will be based upon:

- 1. Cumulative Grade Point Average 40%
- 2. Essay & Resume 35%
- 3. Financial Need 20%
- 4. Letters of Recommendation 5% Total Score 100%

D. **DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS**

The scholarship funds will be disbursed to the recipient's school and may be used for registration, tuition, books, room and board or their reasonable expenses in conjunction with higher education which the Qizhjeh Heritage Institute may determine as acceptable costs. Any funds not used by the recipient will be returned to Kijik Corporation.

E. SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 5. Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- **6.** If the student fails to attend school the semester, quarter or term, the scholarship for that term is forfeited. (If so, please advise Kijik Corporation)

F. KIJIK'S RESPONSIBILTY

Kijik will make payment directly to the school, college, program or learning institution.

G. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

No scholarship shall be less than \$250.



Qizhjeh Heritage Institute Scholarship Application Tips & Suggestions

- 1. *Present a neat and complete scholarship application*. Do not leave any portion of the application blank. Remember, your application represents you to the selection committee!
- 2. **Submit your application well in advance of the deadline date**. Only COMPLETE applications will be considered to be fair to all applicants. It is your responsibility to make sure your application packet is complete. If you mail your application, send it "certified/return receipt".
- 3. **Remember that your Essay is very important; combined with your resume, it is worth 35% of the grading criteria!!** This is your opportunity to personalize your application and convince the review committee to select you as a scholarship recipient. The committee will be looking for applicants who have strong career goals and the desire to succeed in their chosen field of study.

4. Include a summary of the following activities in your resume:

- a. How you became interested in the field of study
- b. Special circumstances that you want the selection committee to know (e.g. financial, academic performance, etc.)
- c. Level of desire to work in the region or for the KIJIK/Subsidiary Companies

5. Other topics you might want to highlight are:

- a. In School Activities (organization membership, offices held, etc.) Out of School Activities (organization membership, offices held, etc.) Community Service Activities
- b. Honors and Awards
- 6. *Give the people that you ask to write your letters of recommendation the appropriate information about yourself if they don't already have it:* field of study, background, grade point average, etc.) Give them plenty of advance time to write the letters and ask for more than one copy (or make copies yourself) so that you can use them for more than one application, if necessary. Please note that your letters of recommendation must be current and dated within 90 days.



Other Suggestions

- Apply for scholarships from the college, university or technical school that you want to attend.
- *Research other scholarships available through your local schools, Native organizations,* village corporations, tribal councils and businesses in your community.
