



Remote Camp Cleaner and Helper

Position Overview

We are seeking a dependable and hardworking Remote Camp Helper / Cleaner to support facility upkeep at a camp in a remote Alaska location. This is a periodic cleaning role, with scheduled cleanings every 12-14 days throughout the season. The successful candidate must be comfortable working in a remote, wilderness setting and able to work efficiently and independently when on site.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform thorough cleaning of all camp facilities every 12-14 days, including sleeping quarters, bathrooms, common areas, and the cook shack
- Dispose of waste and manage garbage in accordance with environmental and camp policies
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of equipment storage areas
- Report facility maintenance issues or safety hazards to the camp or program manager
- Assist with other general camp duties as needed during cleaning visits

Qualifications

- Prior experience in a remote camp, hospitality, janitorial, or similar setting preferred, but not required
- Ability to work independently and efficiently within a scheduled cleaning rotation
- Strong work ethic, reliability, and attention to detail
- Physical ability to perform manual labor including lifting, bending, and standing for extended periods
- Must be able to follow camp rules, safety protocols, and environmental guidelines

Working Conditions

- Scheduled cleaning visits every 12 days — not a live-in position
- Meals provided during on-site visits
