



Field Assistant/Laborer

Location: In or near Nondalton, AK

Position Overview

The Geophysical Survey Field Assistant will support the DIAS Geophysical contractor at the Groundhog exploration project, which is being operated by Falcon Copper Alaska. The Field Assistant role will assist in the collection of Induced Polarization “IP” data by clearing survey lines, carrying and laying out wires and electrode stations, setting up instrumentation as needed, and transporting heavy equipment. The position is required to work outdoors traversing rugged terrain in all weather conditions while ensuring safety protocols are followed.

The duration of the job is approximately 2 months (~mid-May to mid-July). Crew schedules are not yet determined, but a typical rotation will consist of 3 weeks of continuous work (approx. 10-hour days) followed by a shorter rest period.

Key Responsibilities

- **Field Assistance:** Setting up, testing, and dismantling geophysical equipment as directed by the Geophysical Contractor.
- **Data Collection & Logistics:** Assisting in collecting electrical data to help analyze the subsurface as a mineral exploration tool.
- **Physical Labor:** Carrying heavy equipment (up to 50+ lbs) through difficult terrain and clearing brush along survey lines.
- **Safety Adherence:** Identifying hazards, maintaining a safe working environment, and adhering to strict health and safety protocols.
- **Navigation & Layout:** Utilizing GPS and compasses to navigate and mark survey points in the field.
- **Equipment Care:** Ensuring equipment and tools are properly maintained.

Qualifications

- **Education:** No education or experience is required, but experience in remote field-based work is preferred.
- **Physical Stamina:** Ability to work outdoors in extreme conditions (rain, heat, cold) and walk long distances.



- **Teamwork:** Ability to work effectively in a team, following Supervisor's instructions.
- **Technical Skills:** Basic knowledge of GPS equipment, radio comms, and data collection apps, as well as familiarity with helicopter supported operations is highly beneficial.

Working conditions

- Transportation to the work site will be provided
- Must be comfortable traveling in a helicopter or small aircraft
